

Little Picassos at Adelaide Zoo FAQs

Do children need to be supervised?

Teachers from Little Picassos have their working with children certificates and can supervise children for the hour during the class. Parents/caregivers need to remain onsite and contactable during this time.

Can I stay with my child?

Absolutely!

Do I need to purchase a ticket for my child to enter the zoo on the day?

General entry tickets are required for the public and free entry into the zoo applies to children with Zoos SA memberships.

I need to change my booking.

You can ring and request to change the date/session time initially booked, but refunds are not issued for any cancellations.

The sessions are booked out and we need a ticket!

Unfortunately our numbers are strictly limited for each session. Once they are booked, we are unable to accommodate any further bookings due to adult/child supervision ratios and pre-purchased materials for the activities.

What time do I need to arrive for my session?

We recommend arriving 10 minutes prior to each class to ensure you are set and ready to go.

Where are the sessions being held at the Zoo?

In the rotunda (across from the Central Lawns).

Can I take photos of the children during the lessons?

Unfortunately, no. Staff and class lessons may not be recorded or photographed. Lessons in progress may not be recorded in any way, this includes photography, video, instagram or snapchat.

What should my child wear?

As it is an art lesson, we recommend wearing old clothes that can get messy. Art smocks will be provided and all materials are 'washable' but sometimes take a lot of washing to get out. Mess happens and mess should be fun, not stressful!
